

# MAP & GRADIENT DIAGRAM

# Birregurra-Forrest

The Tiger Trail will run from Birregurra to Forrest. A 7 km section from Forrest has already been opened for riding. Along the way you will find breweries, wineries, berry farms, cafes and restaurants as well as beautiful remnant forests, broad rolling farming land and points of historic interest.

The Tiger Trail has been named after a Dodge auto-mobile that was converted to carry passengers on the Birregurra to Forrest Line between 1937 and 1952. The conversion included a unique internal turntable system. Up to 10 passengers could cram into this quaint vehicle, which was painted a bright yellow and black scheme and dubbed the 'Tiger'.
