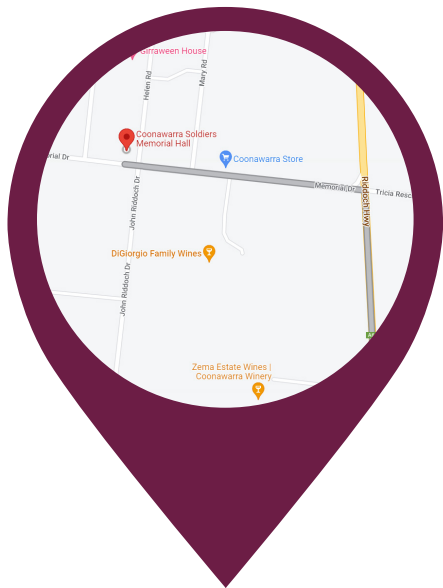


Coonawarra Rail Trail is a shared
